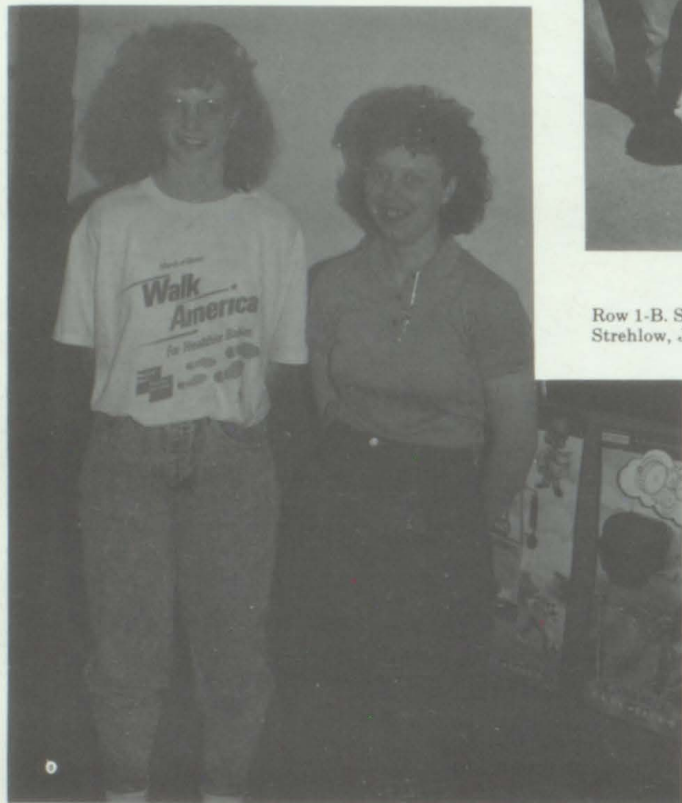






Students receive excellents at one-act play competition.
